On behalf of the Enchanted Circle Regional Fire Association, I am glad to inform you that we will be having a S-290 Intermediate Wildland Fire Behavior. This last year was difficult for the ECRFA, constantly having to adapt the ever-changing environment of COVID-19. I now believe we are in a position to be having hands on courses again.

In order for students to do courses again, students will have to abide by certain procedures.

- 1. Students will have to sign a release from stating that they understand the risks of training in the field up to and including being exposed to COVID-19.
- 2. Student will be required to have tested negative for COVID-19. Negative results should be not older than 14 days.
- 3. Student must also not have traveled out of state or had out of town visitors within 2 weeks prior to the course.
- 4. Student will not have had any contact with anyone that is COVID-19 positive, in quarantine or isolation due to exposure or possible exposure with 2 weeks prior to course start date.
- 5. Students will have to wear a surgical mask during their time in the classrooms sessions.
- 6. COVID-19 Vaccination is strongly encouraged.

If there is an unprotected exposure to a COVID-19 the course coordinator will be contacted and informed of the incident and a description of the circumstances of the exposure. It will be the responsibility of the student's fire district chief to ensure that the student has the means to quarantine/isolate and follow up testing as needed.
