Discussion on High Risk Wildland Response: it was brought up that with the current restrictions and more importantly the fire behavior that was seen on the fires the circle has had that it was best to go into a high risk wildland response at this time. All were in favor of the suggestion James would notify TCD and Deke would notify Red River Dispatch of the change.

C. Discussion on COVID-19 impact on ECRFA operations: it was discussed that we do need to start thinking about Mini-Academy and what we should do in regards to the training and also discuss when quarterly trainings will be happening again and what we need to do to make sure our members are protected from COVID. There were some ideas that floated around but nothing solid we could work off of.

Training:

A: S-130/190: Clayton was still trying to figure out what could be done to still put on the class for the students who are still registered. He also stated if we did actually have the class this year we would have to find a place in Taos County to do the burn because the Colfax County Fire Marshal will not allow them to put fire on the ground. We advised that Taos County could do that if needed. He also stated that he was trying to figure out an online class that could be done.
